

Ananphylaxis

At this stage Islington Public School does not have any students that have Anaphylaxis in attendance at the school.

The Department has recently announced that government schools will receive use adrenaline aeneral autoinjector (an EpiPen) for their first aid kit.

This does not replace the need parents to continue to provide the school with an adrenaline autoinjector and **ASCIA** Action Plan Anaphylaxis signed and dated by their doctor when their child been diagnosed Instead the anaphylaxis. general use adrenaline autoinjector is intended to be used if:

- An undiagnosed student has an anaphylactic reaction at school
- There is a misfire of the adrenaline autoiniector that has been prescribed for a student
- A student requires further adrenaline autoinjector to be administered after his or her own adrenaline autoinjector has been administered.
