Don't forget swimmers, towels, hats and sunscreen next week.

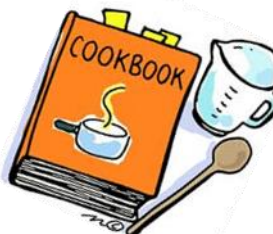

In 2018, we are looking to further grow our player numbers, to give more families the chance to be part of our inclusive & supportive team & allow their child to grow through sport. We are looking for school aged children up to 14 years old (approx.) No previous football experience is required. We cater for both children that can play independently & children who play with the support of a parent, career or volunteer to assist & guide them through the game.

2018 season registrations will be held in February & our season will commence in late March, running through to August, with breaks for Easter & School holidays along the way.
